

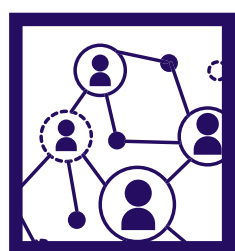
# Have you heard about our Dental Program?



**If you have a bleeding disorder, you could be eligible for free or low cost dental care.**

After hearing countless stories from community members, doctors and nurses, and dental providers alike, we've set out to create a state-wide Dental Program that will address the oral healthcare needs of West Virginians affected by bleeding disorders.

## Dental Program Steps to Success



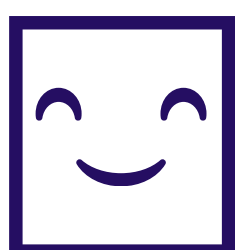
**#1** Create a network of providers who are trained and willing to treat people with bleeding disorders.



**#2** Raise funds for provider and community education and financial assistance.



**#3** The chapter works with HTC's, dentists, and community members to set up appointments.



**#4** Dental visits are less stressful. The dentist planned with your doctor, and you'll have help paying for care.

## FAQS

### Can I use my regular dentist?

We are working to find dentists to participate in the program and will recommend those to community members. Dental offices must agree to the terms of the program before we can provide financial assistance for procedures.

### Which Services Qualify?

Most necessary procedures such as checkups and cleanings, dental assessments, x-rays, fluoride treatments, and extractions qualify. We do not cover cosmetic procedures like teeth whitening.

### How much can I get for assistance?

Assistance depends on the funding available. Contact us to find out more.
